





# TOWNSCAPE HERITAGE INITIATIVE UPDATE

THE PARTY SHOP', CRANE STREET - SIX OUT OF SEVEN SINGLE-STOREY SHOP UNITS NOW RESTORED. The THI has now completed the restoration of the new Party Shop on Crane Street, formerly Eric's Barber's, which opened for business before Christmas. This means that six out of seven of these characteristic and jolly single-storey units have now been restored, and they are all occupied by a variety of local businesses, old and new. Each of these small shops has its own individual character. but all of them have had their shop fronts restored to their original traditional style, and they present a colourful and lively frontage to Crane Street. Also characteristic of these six 19<sup>th</sup> century shops are the tongue and groove ceilings, some original roof trusses, and of course, the J. C. Edwards tiles at Craig's Butcher's!

The Holly Bush is nearing completion, scaffolding is down and most of the new windows are now in place. The building is starting to look good even from the back. In fact the back of the building is likely to become one of three fronts to the building, occupying, as it does, such a prominent position overlooking the Dee Valley and of course the old Plas Kynaston and the gardens that surround it.

# **FUTURE PROJECTS**

**29 Well Street** is still at design stage we hope to bring you more news on this soon.

Plas Kynaston, the old hall and former home of the Kynaston family, who were linked to the Plas Kynaston Foundry, where the ironwork for the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct was cast, is to be restored next year! The Welsh Georgian Trust is close to agreeing to take over the building to oversee its restoration. The THI will contribute to the building's conservation, and it will be restored to provide new housing in the form of six new apartments. Work is also underway, with the Cefn Community Council, to explore the possibility of upgrading and restoring the gardens that surround the old house, for the benefit of local people and visitors alike.

**The Old Bank, Crane Street,** is at design stage with a view to commencing an external restoration scheme which it is hoped will be agreed early in 2015.

**The Queen's Hotel** is another candidate for external restoration work. The new owner intends to open the building as a hotel, thereby restoring it to its original function.
