The sign of the Holly Bush Inn, Oxford Street, Cefn Mawr, LL14 3AE. This sign and the pub are very important to the future of Cefn Mawr. Since the Tesco supermarket opening, Oxford Road, the road built to serve the supermarket has become the main traffic route.

Unfortunately this bypasses the traditional shopping streets of Cefn Mawr, Well Street and Crane Street. Therefore the junction at the top of Hill Street has become particularly important as the primary gateway into the traditional centre of Cefn Mawr. This is the main point of the renovation of the Holly Bush Inn, to try and encourage people using the Tesco Supermarket to also venture onto the traditional shopping streets of Cefn Mawr which will benefit our local economy for all our community.
