



#### **YSGOL ACREFAIR**

We had our first school disco (of recent times) It was very well attended by children in all classes who had a wonderful time dancing, playing party games and eating hot-dogs! Lots of members of staff also came along to join in the fun. We were so proud of the children's excellent behavior and can't wait to do another one in the Autumn term.

The 'Star Dome' from Wrexham Techniquest was in school before the half term break. All classes had a brilliant time learning about all kinds of 'space' related things, from the phases of the moon to navigation using the stars and even star signs!

Year 3 have been doing some wonderful work on the Roman's this half term and have been using their maths skills to design Roman buildings- they are visiting the Dewa Roman experience in June to find out even more.

Year 6 visited the Beatles museum in Liverpool last month. They have been learning all about life in the 60's from the moon landings to the music and fashion.



One Hen continued. As part of our project we bought 13 'Living Eggs' which we kept in an incubator in our classroom. The eggs all hatched Into tiny chicks which we learned how to take care of. We carried out all of the jobs that Kojo would have had to do each day including cleaning our hens out and making sure that they had enough ood and water. Whilst we had the hens we learned about their life cycle and how they grow and reproduce. We also carried out lots of scientific investigations including 'Can an egg breathe?' and 'How strong is an egg?'. We have also learned about life for children in Ghana and we have compared this with our own lives. We have looked at the type of house Kojo would have lived in and have built an African village using modelling clay .We plan to do a sponsored walk down to the river in Ty Mawr to raise money for WaterAid, the walk will be more than 2 miles each way, just like Kojo has to walk for water in the story.
