We held a Super Learning Week for the whole school from Monday 4th November. Each class based their work around the book **Where the Poppies Now Grow**. The pupils planned the week along with the staff. Work included each class from Y1 to Y6 visiting *Cefn Mawr Museum*, with our Nursery and Reception classes having a visit in school entitled *Museum in a Box*.

Local Artist *Marcia Crocombe* worked with the pupils to create a landscape from the book which is now proudly displayed in the school hall.

Pupils experienced making and tasting war time food using rations. Pupils wrote prayers and poems of Remembrance, and discussed themes of bravery, courage and admiration. Pupils designed invitations and invited families to share our special work in an Exhibition afterschool. We held our own Special Service in the hall where each pupil cut out a hand shape from red paper and we laid them around a black centre to make a large whole school poppy. This was our focal point for our 2 minute silence. A wonderful week of creative learning around this time of Remembrance.
